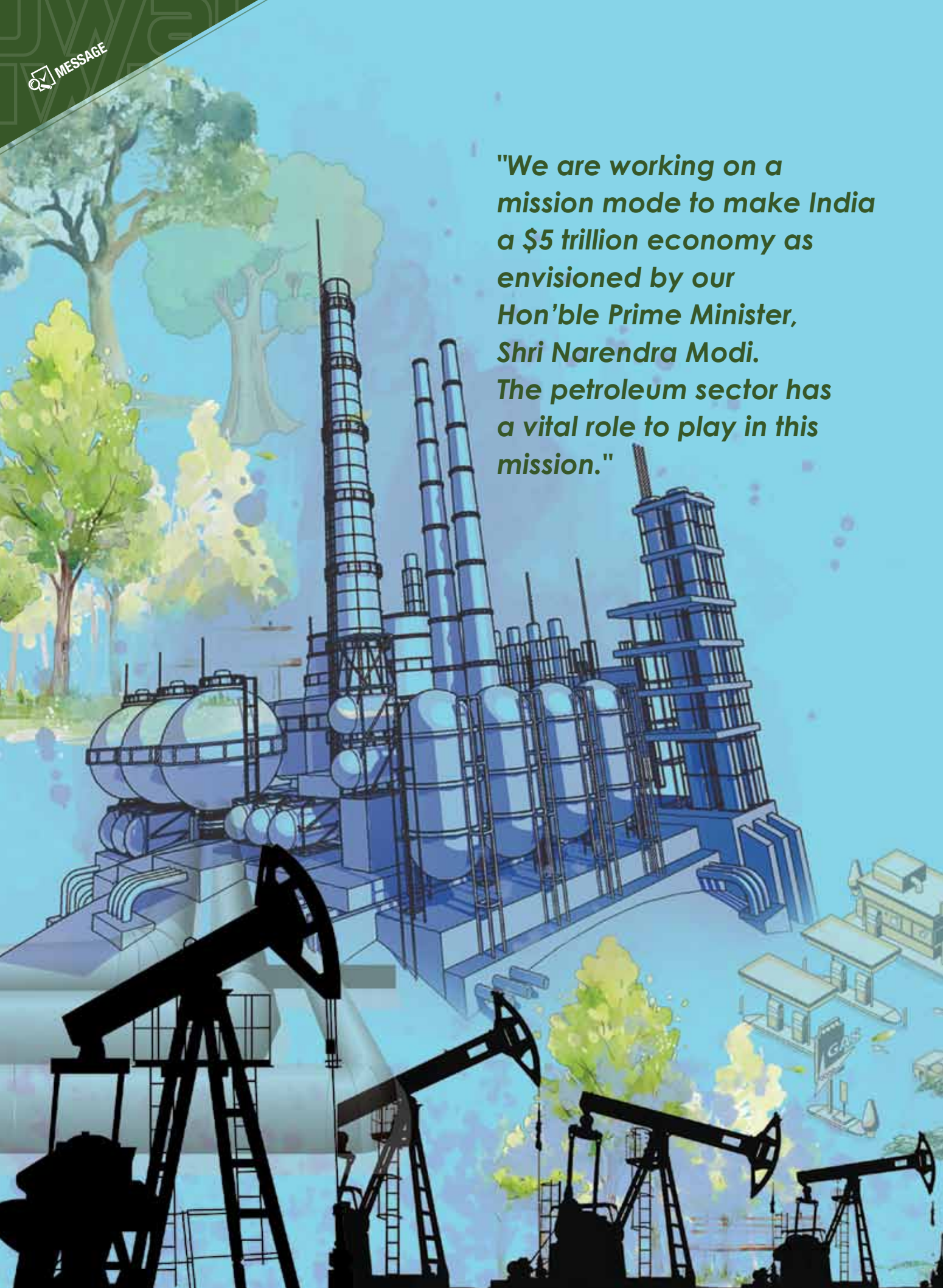

## Steam blowing activity begins at PDPP

Team PDPP achieved a significant milestone with the commencement of steam blowing activity at the PDPP construction site.

Over 3.5 Km long HP steam line was successfully laid from Utility Boiler area inside refinery to the PDPP area. With dedicated

efforts by the commissioning and construction teams, steam blowing was initially started in the refinery area.

After thorough cleaning of the line, steam was taken up to unit battery limits and is now in progress within the acrylic acid unit. The same is a critical activity

prior to the air compressor start up activity and takes the PDPP team another step forward in its commissioning journey.

## New parking facility at MSBP

MSBP construction site was facing acute shortage of space, especially for parking vehicles of contractors and labour staff.

Hence the newly acquired space along the East side of Chailikara gate, which was transferred by HR department to MS Block Project has been developed as parking space. Nearly 8300 m<sup>2</sup> of area was developed for providing the parking facility for vehicles. The new parking area has two wheeler parking with paved area for 2000 m<sup>2</sup> and levelled area for 2400 m<sup>2</sup>, four wheeler parking with paved area for 2100 m<sup>2</sup> and truck parking along the road side for 1800 m<sup>2</sup>

These states if strong and prolonged can increase vulnerability to disease, worsen the symptoms or hinder recovery. On the other hand, more positive states like equanimity and optimism have beneficial effects on health.

How a mother will react to the situation in 3 may be different from that of a father. Similarly, how your colleague will react to situation 1 may be different from that of your own reaction. How you react to any situation in life is characterized by your emotional style. Thousands of people who share similar backgrounds respond in dramatically different ways to the same life event. Some are resilient in the face of stress while others fall apart.

Just as each person has a unique finger print, each of us has a unique emotional profile, one that is so much a part of who we are and how we will respond to an emotional challenge.

This program offered participants an opportunity to examine their own emotional style and understand how it impacts their state of health, their relationship with people and their performance at school, home or office. It provided a gateway to explore the fascinating world of brain, body & emotions and understand their interconnections and impact in our lives. The program also provided ample opportunities to explore our universe of thoughts, feelings and emotions and understand the linkages between our bodily systems and eastern philosophies. 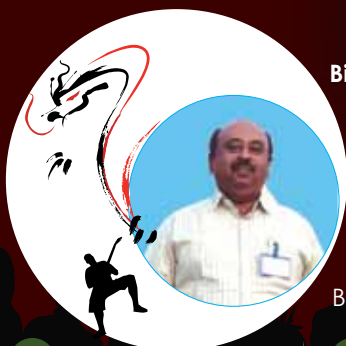

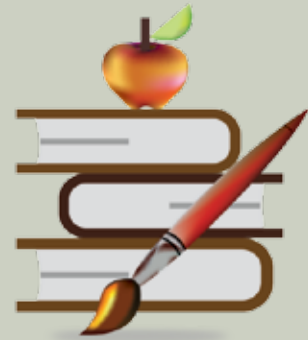
