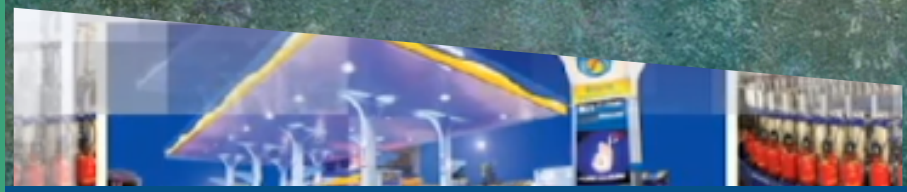

FREE MEDICAL OXYGEN TO GOVT HOSPITALS

At an industry-first moment, District Collector Mr. S Suhas IAS flagged off the first truck of FREE Medical Oxygen to Government Hospitals from Bharat Petroleum Kochi Refinery. A CSR initiative of BPCL Kochi Refinery in association with M/s Air Products, this is a special initiative for saving lives with medical oxygen, one of the most pressing needs during these COVID times. Mr. Murali Madhavan P, Executive Director (Kochi Refinery) presided over the inaugural ceremony at Kochi Refinery on 12 October 2020.

Also speaking on the occasion were Mr. Subramoni Iyer M R, Chief General Manager (Refinery Operations) and Mr. Kurian P Alapatt, Chief General Manager (HR). Felicitating the venture over video conference were Dr. R Venugopal, Deputy Chief Controller of Explosives (PESO) and Mr. Richard Boocock, Senior Vice President (Air Products). With the outbreak of COVID -19 pandemic, the demand for Medical Oxygen has spiked with rapid surge in the spread of pandemic.

Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas has been requesting Refineries to explore possibilities for producing Medical grade Oxygen with available facilities in the Refineries to support the Government authorities handle the situation. The Build-Own-Operate unit of BPCL-KR, operated by M/s Prodair Air Products India Pvt Limited has a provision to produce and store Liquid Oxygen of 99.7% purity. This Liquid Oxygen is expected to meet the Medical grade specification. Central and State Government agencies like Centre for High Technology (CHT), Factories & Boilers, PESO have been in contact with BPCL & Prodair Air Products and have been offering all support for this noble initiative of BPCL & Prodair Air Products. Considering the urgency of the situation, with the unprecedented spurt in COVID 19 cases and medical

Oxygen shortage in Kerala, BPCL and AP explored and established the possibility of producing 10 tons/week of Liquid Oxygen which will meet medical grade oxygen specifications. Liquid Oxygen, thus produced by Air Product, will be supplied to Ernakulam Government Medical College, Ernakulam General Hospital and PVS-Government Covid Apex Center for a period of two months. Approximately 90 Tonnes of medical grade oxygen is expected to be supplied free of cost under the CSR /CER initiative of BPCL & Prodair Air Products. Also present at the flag-off ceremony were Mr. Haris Rasheed IAS, Sub Collector (Fort Kochi), Mr. Velayudhan PK, President (Vadavucode Puthencruz Panchayat), Dr. Ravi PV, President (IMA - Kochi Chapter), Dr. Satish, Principal (Govt Medical College, Ekm), Mr. Jayashankar Krishnan, Factory Manager (Prodair Air Products), Mr. Antony Joseph, (Manorama Oxygen) and Mr. George Thomas, General Manager (PR & Admin), and Mr. CD Mahesh, Chief Manager (Process Engineering), Kochi Refinery, From energising lives, BPCL is all out to saving lives with this initiative as we #Unite2FightCorona.

A GUIDE TO USING MASKS



Before putting on a mask, clean hands with alcohol-based hand rub or soap and water.
